On July 21, 2011, the Navajo Nation Telecommunications Regulatory Commission (NNTRC or Commission) adopted and released the Notice of Proposed Rule Making in the matter of Application for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN). The NNTRC Office set the final deadline for submission of written comments for October 14, 2011, and has posted received comments to the NNTRC website for public review. Pursuant to 21 N.N.C. § 515, the NNTRC has set the above date and place for interested parties to comment and respond to the NNTRC directly in a public format.

Interested parties who wish to speak during the Special Meeting to be held on February 1, 2012 should file a summary of their oral comments (two pages or less, double spaced, Font: Times New Roman size 12), to be received on or before January 30, 2012, with the Office of the NNTRC, addressed to the Executive Director, Office of the NNTRC, at the contact information below. Parties filing oral comments will generally be given priority in the order of receipt, at the sole discretion of the NNTRC Chairperson. Initial oral comments are limited to five minutes. Additional time for comments may be given at the discretion of the Chairperson, or to respond to questions of Commissioners. Interested parties wishing to speak who have not filed oral comments with the Office of the NNTRC by the due date may still be able to speak, subject to available time.
